

All In: Pt.3 - Not On Our Watch

This is a call to action for the church community to commit to raising resilient disciples, encouraging active participation and nurturing relationships for both parents and children.

Bottom Line: We must commit ourselves to raising the strongest generation of disciples of Jesus.

Discussion Questions:

- 1. What is a memorable tradition or activity from your childhood that you think helped shape who you are today?
- 2. What role does prayer, commitment, and service play in fulfilling the mission of raising strong disciples?
- 3. Why is it important for parents to be disciples of Jesus themselves before they can disciple their children?
- 4. **Read Deuteronomy 6:4–9**. How does this passage guide parents in teaching their children about God? Why is this important?
- 5. **Read Deuteronomy 30:15–20**. How does this passage challenge us to choose a life of faithfulness for ourselves and our descendants?
- 6. **Read Judges 2:6–13**. How does this passage illustrate the consequences of failing to pass on faith to the next generation? What can we do, as followers of Jesus, to avoid failing also?
- 7. **Read 2 Timothy 1:5 & 2 Timothy 3:10–15**. How do these verses highlight the importance of mentorship and spiritual heritage in a believer's life.
- 8. What are you personally doing to grow in your own relationship with Jesus Christ? Is there more that you can be doing? Discuss.
- 9. What has been the most helpful thought/idea from the message this week? How has that thought/idea helped you?
- 10. How can the group encourage you this week?
