



All In: Pt.4 - Love and Sacrifice

God is calling us to reflect on what we hold dear and consider how we can go "ALL IN" for the sake of the Gospel. The mission of the church is worthy of the investment of your life.

Bottom Line: Love moves us to sacrifice.

Discussion Questions:

1. If you could witness any event from the Bible firsthand, which one would you choose and what would you hope to learn from it?
2. What does sacrifice mean to you? Describe a time when you made a large sacrifice. What motivated you to do that?
3. What does it mean to go 'ALL IN' when it comes to serving God and others?
4. **Ephesians 5:2 (TLB)** says, "Be full of love for others, following the example of Christ who loved you and gave himself to God as a sacrifice to take away your sins. And God was pleased, for Christ's love for you was like sweet perfume to him." Love is a powerful motivator for sacrifice, akin to how Jesus sacrificed for the joy of our salvation. How does love guide our decision to sacrifice something for someone we love or an important cause we love?
5. It's true that everyone has a treasure jar - something valuable, something that we love. Think about your own treasure jar. How does it influence your willingness to contribute to church or community efforts?
6. **Read Matthew 6:33.** Describe a time when you gave up something that you loved for something that you loved more?
7. What has been the most helpful thought/idea from the message this week? How has that thought/idea helped you?
8. How can the group encourage you this week?

Action Step: *Prayerfully consider what sacrifice you're willing to consider making for the church's mission. Ask God to show you the right sacrifice that he has for you in this season. Take time now to go to God in prayer over this.*
